The proposed launch of the HLP concept in Plymouth is the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2012, and there are a number of training activities that will need to be completed before the pharmacy can achieve HLP core status. Firstly, there will be leadership training over two evenings for the pharmacy manager (pharmacist/non-pharmacist), and secondly there will be a training day for the nominated Health Promotion Champions using the Royal Society of Public Health's Level 2 Award in 'Understanding Health Improvement'.

Devon LPC, Plymouth Public Health and NHS Plymouth are hoping to offer both training days at no cost to the pharmacy, some HLP pilots have charged for these training opportunities.
