Integrated Teams in Action

Developing integrated care systems in Trafford has six design principles that have been used throughout the process of scoping the new integrated health system:

- general practice should be the 'locus of integration'
- consultant opinion is an essential component of effective integrated services
- the delivery of integrated services will primarily rest on extended roles for nursing and allied health professionals
- integrated services will be enhanced by the involvement of social care
- the voluntary sector and carers need a strong voice in the design and delivery of services
- future integrated services would bring together the full range of primary care services.

Clinical leadership is central to the development of the new integration plans, and a number of 'clinical congress' meetings have been held. Each of these areas will establish multidisciplinary clinical panels, responsible for identifying models of care and quality measures. These panels will be accountable to an overall clinical board which is intended to become the most powerful body within the new ICS, undertaking evaluation and answering the fundamental question of whether integration is making things better.

LTC Commissioning Development Programme: Update

Work has commenced in the North West with the close of applications and orientation and status diagnostic WebExs during October with the first event for Workstream members only set for 29th November.
