

How to become a pharmacist able to treat Chlamydia

1. Complete the CPPE training on sexual health (www.cppe.ac.uk)
2. Complete the CPPE training on PGDs
3. Complete the CPPE on Safeguarding Children
4. Send certificate to Kelvin.Rowland-Jones@cambridgeshire.nhs.uk
5. Kelvin will post you:
 - Paperwork to claim payment for screening
 - LES to sign and return
 - PGD to sign and return
6. On return of the forms you will be ready to treat. The Chlamydia Screening Health Advisor will be informed by the Medicines Management that you are up and running and so she will start booking-in patients to see you.

Tips for passing the CPE:

The sexual health CPPE in particular can be hard to pass with some ambiguous questions so some tips for passing:

- Coach each other through the difficult questions
- Use the e-mail the tutor facility in the module
- Call the Chlamydia screening Health Advisor who can also provide some advice on tricky questions
