Our Advanced Practice accredited CPD courses are multi-professional and ideal as part of your CPD portfolio, or used toward an Advanced Practice award supporting the development for senior roles in health, including the Consultant Pharmacist pathway and Pharmacists with Special Interest accreditation.

Courses blend flexible peer, action and work-based learning, supported by web-based resources and online discussion events to develop your area of expertise. Occasional face-to-face professional conferences develop your new knowledge and skills, engage with ideas and concepts at the forefront of service delivery and network with other professionals.

## Advanced Clinical Practice

Develop your consultation and advanced clinical practice skills as well as improving your expertise in critical appraisal, creating and critiquing policy and practice documents and developing advanced skills in communicating complex clinical and practice information. Evaluate, plan and implement practice enhancements, service developments, and develop your networks. This CPD course is mapped to the Advanced and Consultant Level Framework and experiences from your own clinical environment will be crucial the development of your skills.

Courses carry Level 7 postgraduate credits (12 ECTS or 20 CATS points) and take around 5 months to complete. Study courses for CPD or accumulate credit over time for a Postgraduate Certificate, Diploma or MSc in Advanced and Specialist Healthcare practice. If you are returning to learning after a break, we also run an Enhancing Professional Skills course (3 credits) throughout the year. It is possible to claim for Approval for Prior Experiential Learning (APEL) or to transfer credit from other organisations.

### Fees and bursaries:

Courses cost £900 including learning materials, online support, induction and conference (fees exclude travel and accommodation). For a limited period, pharmacists and technicians working in SW Hospital Trusts can apply for a 50% SWMIT bursary.
